Ambassador: Sir Bob Charles



While not Canterbury born, Sir Bob Charles has made Canterbury his home for nearly 60 years since moving south from the Wairarapa. Having won New Zealand's Golf Open as an 18-year-old amateur he turned professional in 1960, just as golf was about to take

off thanks to extensive television coverage.

He soon established himself as the game's best left-hander and achieved several firsts as a left-hander winning on the PGA tour. His finest moment was winning the 1963 Open Championship at Royal Lytham and St. Annes.

Another high-ranked performance was winning the 1969 World Matchplay Championship. Once he moved to the Senior PGA tour he found more success, winning 23 titles.

He won the Senior British Open 30 years after winning his title in 1963 – the first major win by a left-hander. He now lives in Christchurch at Clearwater, overlooking a golf course he helped design.

"Christchurch has a number of excellent golf courses," Sir Bob said. "So Christchurch can accommodate quite a lot of golfers.

"A feature of Christchurch's courses is that they are all flat, there are no hilly golf courses so that means easy walking," he said. "Golf to me is the game of a lifetime, my dad played until he was 90 years of age, my mother played well into her 80s and the great thing about golf is that you don't need an opponent. You make lifelong friends, it's a great social game. You go out and have a round of golf with your friends, or an opponent, and if you lose you buy the winner a drink. To be a member of the club, to meet up with all your friends whether at the weekend or whatever it's a great social occasion."

As the 2018 Golden Oldies World Golf Festival ambassador Sir Bob Charles is sure that will be the case in Christchurch as well.

Christchurch is a city in transformation and the Christchurch Casino Golden Oldies Sports Celebration 2018 will be a great opportunity to be part of a revival of spirit in this proud sporting city. Christchurch, the main centre of the Canterbury region, has a proud sporting history with many top quality performers and teams reaching international success across a variety of sports. In each of those sports making up the Celebration, Cantabrians are very familiar with the highest levels of their games. That would be enough on

its own to make the occasion memorable. Christchurch is the largest city in New Zealand's South Island and is often referred to as the 'Garden City' due to its stunning parks, gardens and tree lined streets.

Christchurch and the surrounding Canterbury region is a hive of activity where within just two hours of the international airport you could be bungee jumping, rafting, skiing, hot air ballooning, whale watching or sampling fine wine at the regions world class wineries.

Players will gather at designated host Golf Clubs for the second round of play – Stableford and Stroke play. Food and beverage will be available during the day followed by hospitality and awards at the end of play. The evening will be free to enjoy local restaurants and bars in the city.

Wednesday 11th of April

The popular Picnic Day will see teams transferred to Hanmer Springs for an enjoyable day of great Canterbury food and beverages in addition to local entertainment and some interesting and memorable activities. At the conclusion of a great day out in wonderful Canterbury, teams will be transferred back to their accommodation and the chance to enjoy an evening at one of Christchurch's many excellent restaurants or bars including the Entertainment HQ at the Christchurch Casino.

Thursday 12th of April

Players will gather at designated host Golf Clubs for the third round of play – Stableford and Stroke play. Food and beverage will be available during the day followed by hospitality and awards at the end of play. The evening will be free to enjoy local restaurants and bars in the city.

Friday 13th of April

Players will gather at designated host Golf Clubs for the final round of play – Stableford and Stroke play. Food and beverage will be available during the day followed by hospitality and awards at the end of play. Early evening players will make their way to the Finale Dinner and Awards Evening. A wonderful end to the week featuring a three course served meal, an open bar for beer, wine and juices, presentation of Festival Awards and some very special entertainment. Four to five hours of Fun, Friendship and Fraternity at the end of a great week in a fabulous city.


Saturday 14th of April

CATEGORY A: (4.5 to 5 star)

The George Hotel, 50 Park Terrace, is a luxury, boutique, award-winning hotel situated across the road from the Avon River and overlooking Hagley Park. 15 minutes stroll from the city centre and the Christchurch Casino. Two award winning restaurants and regularly judged New Zealand's leading boutique hotel in World Travel Awards.

Rydges Latimer Hotel, 30 Latimer Square, is an excellent, relaxed hotel with modern rooms featuring free Wi-Fi, TV, minibar, and tea and coffee-making facilities. It will be the Headquarters Hotel for the Festivals. A 10-minute walk from the city and the Christchurch Casino. The hotel has a relaxed spacious bar and restaurant and has a fully equipped gymnasium and an inviting sauna.

Heritage Christchurch Hotel, 28-30 Cathedral Square, is located in a charming old Government Department Building converted into a superb apartment style hotel. The various accommodation options offer self-contained apartments with full kitchen facilities, dishwasher, microwave and oven, open plan dining and lounge downstairs. Bedroom, bathroom and laundry are upstairs. Free Wi-Fi, excellent restaurant, lap pool, spa pool, sauna and gymnasium on site. Unique rooms of different shapes and sizes feature complimentary Wi-Fi, tea and coffee making facilities, TV and an extensive mini-bar. Hotel charge back facilities at local cafes and restaurants and very handy to the city centre and Christchurch Casino. Easy access to the iconic Christchurch Tram Services and easy to move around the city.

Sudima Hotel, corner of Memorial Ave & Orchard Rd, Christchurch. Ideally located just five minutes' walk from Christchurch International and Domestic Airport, Sudima Christchurch Airport is the perfect stepping stone to the stunning South Island.
