Women's Competitions: A 4 Day 18 Hole Stableford competition and an optional one day Stableford 18 Hole competition on the Wednesday.

Mixed Men & Women Competition: A 4 Day 9 hole Stableford competition.

All 4 day competitions will include nearest the pin and twos competitions. A small charge will apply to the two's competition. Further information regarding the competitions and conditions of entry is provided overleaf.

Registration: All entrants in the 4 Day competitions are required to register in the upstairs lounge of the Club on Sunday 5th November from mid day onwards and will receive an entry gift pack. Tournament Dates: The Tournament will run from Monday 6th November to Friday 10th of November 2017 at the Taupo Golf Club.

Handicap Divisions: The Men's 4 Day 18 hole Handicap Match Play Competition will be played in handicap divisions of 16 players. The Women's 4 Day 18 hole Stableford competition will be played in two handicap divisions of equal, or near equal numbers.

Handicap divisions for Men and Women for the duration of the tournament will be based on the entrant's handicap index as at Thursday 2^{nd} November.

Playing Handicap: Cards will be issued daily. If your handicap changes during the week of the tournament you will play subsequent rounds based on your new handicap.

Courses: The two lowest handicap divisions in the Men's 4 Day 18 hole handicap match play competition will play on the Centennial Course and the higher handicap divisions will play on the Tauhara Course. The Women's 4 Day Stableford competition will be played on the Tauhara Course. Men and Women playing in the 4 day 9 hole competitions will play the front and back nine's of the Centennial and Tauhara courses over the four days, playing on a different course each day.

The Wednesday one day Stableford competitions will be played on the Tauhara course. The Wednesday competitions will include competitions for the Die Hards, Longest and straightest drives and nearest the pin.

Days of Play: The 4 Day competitions will be played on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesday is a rest day, or if you wish you can play in the optional one day Stableford competition.

Tee Off Times: The 4 Day competitions start at 8.30 am each day with men off first. The last to tee off should be no later than about 10.00am. The Wednesday Stableford competitions for Men and Women will rely on a shot gun start at 9.00am.

Draws for the 4 Day competitions: We will endeavor to email to all 4 Day entrants on Saturday 4th November the Monday draw for the Men's 4 Day 18 Hole Match Play competition and the 4 day draw for all other competitions. These draws will be available to view at the Sunday registration.

Practice Round: Visitors may have a free practice round on Sunday 5th November after registration.

Motor Homes: Entrants in the 4 Day competitions may park their own self contained motor homes at the western end of the Car Park at no cost for the duration of the Tournament.

Cafeteria: In addition to providing lunch, morning and afternoon tea & coffee, breakfast will be available every morning from 7:30am.

Conditions of Entry:

- (1) Entry is open to all Veteran golfers.
- (2) Veteran golfers are defined as Women 50 years of age and over and Men 55 years of age and over.
- (3) Entrants in the four day competitions will have priority of entry in the Wednesday one day competitions.
- (4) Men 75 years and over on 8th November 2016 qualify as a DIEHARD.
- (5) The rules of the Tournament shall be those of "The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews" except as varied by the local rules of the Taupo Golf Club Inc.
- (6) Your date of entry will be the date the Society has received both your entry form and entry fee.
- (7) Entry may be refused by the Taupo Veteran Golfers Society without being required to give a reason.
- (8) The Taupo Veteran Golfers Society reserves the right to change the program either before or during the Tournament.
- (9) Decisions of the Taupo Veteran Golfers Society shall be final.
- (10) Any protest must be lodged in writing to the Taupo Veteran Golfers Society within 30 minutes of completion of the round
