

## **Correct Answers 6**

**Question 1**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: See the definition of Outside Influence.

**Question 2**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: See the definition of Drop.

**Question 3**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: See the definition of Abnormal Course Condition.

**Question 4**                      **Correct answer B**

Explanation: As per the definition of Foursomes, this is a form of play where two partners compete as a side by playing one ball in alternating order on each hole.

**Question 5**                      **Correct answer B**

Explanation: A player may ground his or her club anywhere in a penalty area without penalty (Rule 17.1b).

**Question 6**                      **Correct answer C**

Explanation: There is no penalty if a player causes her ball to move while trying to find or identify it. If the ball is moved during the search, the ball must be replaced on its original spot (which if not known must be estimated) (Rule 7.4).

**Question 7**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: See Rule 15.2a.

**Question 8**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: If a ball has been dropped in the right way twice and both times comes to rest outside the relief area, the player must complete taking relief by placing a ball on the spot where the ball dropped the second time, first touched the ground (Rule 14.3c).

**Question 9**                      **Correct answer B**

Explanation: When a ball is lifted from a part of the course other than a putting green because it interferes with play, cleaning is not allowed (Rule 14.1c).

**Question 10**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: Any grass, bush, tree or other growing or attached natural object rooted in the defined area, including any part of those objects that extends up above the ground outside the edge of the defined area, but not any part (such as a tree root) that is attached to or below the ground outside the edge of the defined area. See Definition of Ground Under Repair.

**Question 11**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: A concession is final - it cannot be withdrawn once it is made and it cannot be declined (Rule 3.2a).

**Question 12**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: See Rule 18.2a.

**Question 13**                      **Correct answer B**

Explanation: A hole made by an animal is an abnormal course condition.

**Question 14**                      **Correct answer B**

Explanation: See Rule 6.4a.

**Question 15**                      **Correct answer B**

Explanation: See the definition of In Play.

**Question 16**                      **Correct answer C**

Explanation: Since she started with 13 clubs, she was entitled to add another club under Rule 4.1b(1).

**Question 17**                      **Correct answer A**

Explanation: See the definition of Equipment.

**Question 18**                      **Correct answer B**

Explanation: Before a player makes a stroke at her ball in a bunker, she must not touch sand in the area right in front of or right behind her ball. See Rule 12.2b for further details.
