# **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

### **CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

Open to a "Team Entry" consisting of one Lady and one Man Over the age of 50 and 55 respectively, with a Current Handicap.

Entry Fee of \$90.00 per team must accompany the Entry Form. Pse include a stamped self-addressed envelope, or an email address, for first day draw. Should you be unable to access the draw, please phone the Tournament Convenor.

The **Maximum Course Handicaps** will be 36 for Men and 40 for Women. The teams are seeded to groups on combined handicaps, all rounds Nett Competition.

The rules of play shall be those of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and as allowed by the local rules of the Club being played each day.

The Decision of the Committee of the Day on any point shall be final. All protests must be lodged within thirty minutes of the completion of the round.

### The Committee shall have the right to decline Entry from any person without giving a reason, and the decision on all such matters will be FINAL.

No refund if entry withdrawn after 8th April, or by discretion of the Committee.

If a cart is required, please indicate on entry form as only a certain number available.

#### AMERICAN FOURSOMES. 40% HANDICAP

Both players tee off then play partner's ball for second shot. Chosen ball is then played by the owner and continue alternately to the hole.

## KIWI FOURSOMES. 50% HANDICAP

Playing one ball, taking alternate tee shots. Players will be told which tee the Men/Ladies will play.

## **CANADIAN FOURSOMES.** 40% HANDICAP

Both Players tee off from their respective tees select the ball they wish to play. The second player takes the next shot, followed alternately.

Each Player must take Eight Tee Shots

#### **SCOTTISH FOURSOMES. 50% HANDICAP**

The Players use **ONE** Ball and take alternate shots until the Game is Finished. The Players will decide who takes the First Tee Shot.
